## **30 hour Provision**

Dear Parents,

As the 30 hour sessions are aimed to provide continuous provision and to fit in with the whole school day, the sessions will run from 8.40am till 3.20pm.

The 30 hour funded entitlement does not cover the entire day, therefore there will be a charge of £3.50 per day to cover the additional time, which is £17.50 per week.

If a child is absent due to illness/holiday etc., fees will still be charged. If the school is closed for reasons beyond our control you will not be charged.

### **Payments should always be made in advance either monthly or termly to school.**

A deposit of £50 is now due and can be used as an initial payment. A Statement of account will be issued at the start of term and then each month thereafter. You will also need to provide your 10 digit eligibility code from HMRC. Without your code you cannot access 30 hour provision.

From September, once your child has started Nursery, you will be able to pay using an online system (further details will be given in September). If you wish to pay by childcare vouchers, please see the school office who will arrange registration with your childcare voucher provider.

If payments are not made, your child will not be able to access the additional time.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch each day and they will be provided with school milk and fruit at break times.
