Dear Parents

A trip has been arranged for Classes Y5R & Y5H to Knowsley Safari Park. This is linked to the Science Curriculum topic about life cycles of different animals.

The trip will be on **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> July**. The children should be in school before 9.00 am as usual - as the coach will leave at 9.15am and will return by **3.30pm**.

School uniform is to be worn. Please ensure the children wear suitable coats, shoes etc. The children will need a packed lunch in a plastic carrier bag which can be thrown away. Please ensure drinks are in disposable cartons or bottles. Children who take Free Meals may order a packed lunch from school.

We would like to recommend that you include your child in our proposed trip and return the attached Parental Consent for a School Visit form with payment by **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July**. If the consent form is not returned to school, your child will **NOT** be able to take part in the visit.

It is necessary to ask you for a voluntary contribution if the visit is to take place. We have to explain that should you decide not to contribute, the law states that your child should be entitled to take part. However, because there is no substantial alternative funding, a voluntary contribution of **£18.50** to cover the cost of coach, entry fee and the hands-on experience with rainforest creatures by experts will ensure that the visit occurs.
