An odd number is any whole number that has a remainder if divided by 2 (or shared between 2)

An even number is any whole number that can be divided by 2 (shared between 2) without leaving a remainder

An array is an arrangement of objects or pictures in rows and columns of equal groups

A multiple is the result when you multiply one whole number by another whole number

A factor of a number is any whole number that divides into it exactly

A square number is a positive number that is the result of multiplying a number by itself

A prime number has only two factors - it can only be divided by 1 and itself

A composite number is a whole number that has three or more factors

A positive number is any number above zero

A negative number is any number below zero

A cube number is a positive number that is the result of multiplying a whole number by itself, then multiplying by itself again
